RULES:

1. Entries will be received from 3:00 to 8:00 pm Mon., August 8th at the Attala County Coliseum.
2. Exhibits will be open to the public from 5:00 to 8:00 pm Wednesday, August 10 through Friday, August 12, 2011.
3. Exhibits will remain on display through Friday, August 12, 2011. Exhibits may be removed
4. between 7:00 and 9:00 am on Saturday, August 13, 2011.
5. Ribbons will be given on three divisions: Adult Male, Adult Female and Youth.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Exhibits must be fish or game harvested by the exhibitor in any year prior to the fair that has not previously won.
2. No prize winning exhibit previously shown at the Central Mississippi Fair Fin, Horn, & Feather shows may be exhibited.
3. All exhibits must be labeled with exhibitors name, address and phone number.
4. Exhibitors may have as many as two entries in each class.
5. Exhibits of fish or game must represent a species native to the Central Mississippi area and must be regarded as a game species. Exception will be made for taxidermy for display only.
6. Entrants in the youth division must be age 18 or younger.
7. Entrants in the adult division must be age 19 or over.

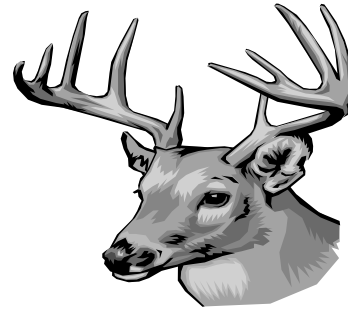

26. CLASS - DEER RACKS

Judging will be based on official point system.
Racks only and shoulder mounts will be treated alike.

27. CLASS - FISH

Judging will be based on weight only.

- Lot 116—Largemouth Bass
- Lot 117—Bream
- Lot 118—Crappie

28. CLASS - TURKEY BEARDS

- Lot 119—With single beard. Judging based on length of beard only.
- Lot 120—With multiple beards. Judging based on combined length of beards.
