BEEF SHOW RULES:

1. The show will be open to all recognized beef breeds.
2. All animals must be placed by 8:00a.m. Saturday, August 14, 2011.
3. Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service Form 195 must be in the Attala County Agent's Office by Friday, August 5, 2011.
4. All entries must be entered in appropriate age class.
5. Animals must be entered in appropriate age class.
6. No premium will be paid on animals that the judge deems unworthy. No premium will be paid on white ribbons.
7. Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes will be awarded, but no additional premium money will be paid.
8. All animals must meet health requirements.
9. All exhibitors showing bulls must use a nose lead or the animal cannot enter the show ring.
10. All steers will be classified by weight and not by breeds.
11. Animals will be released after show on Saturday.

SHEEP SHOW RULES:

1. Sheep must be owned by exhibitor 30 days prior to show.
2. Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service Form 195 must be in the Attala County Agent's Office by Friday, August 5, 2011.
3. All lambs must have their lamb teeth to be eligible to show.
4. Lambs who have lost center pair of teeth are ineligible to show in Junior Market Lamb Show.
5. All market lambs will be weighed and divided into equal classes by weight and breed.
6. All market lambs must have ear tags.
7. All animals must be in place by 8:00a.m. Saturday, August 14, 2011.
8. Exhibits will be released Saturday after Show.
9. All animals must meet health requirements.

GOAT SHOW RULES:

1. Goats must be owned by exhibitor 30 days prior to show.
2. Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service Form 195 must be in the Attala County Agent's Office by Friday, August 5, 2011.
3. All market goats will be weighed and divided into equal classes by weight.
4. All market goats must have ear tags.
5. All animals must meet health requirements.
6. All dairy goats must have proof of registration with their breed association.
7. All dairy goats must be tattooed.
8. There will be no pre-show milkout for dairy goats.
9. Dairy Goat classes will be broken into Jr. Does (never freshened) and Sr. Does (have freshened).
10. No horns are allowed on dairy goats.
11. All animals must be in place by 12:00 Noon., Saturday, August 13, 2011.
12. Exhibits will be released Saturday, August 13, 2011, following the show.

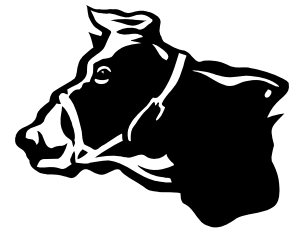
